1.Expressionist artists seek to express their subject's **feelings**, **moods**, and **emotions** or themselves, rather than representing the real world.

2. Edvard Munch was a Norwegian Expressionist painter. His best-known work is *The Scream*, which has become an iconic image in the art world.

3. In Expressionist art, the use of colour is highly **intense** and **non-naturalistic.** The application of colour is freely applied and **textural.**

5. A **portrait** is a picture of a person that can be created through drawing, painting and photography. **Artistic** movements or artists that communicate feelings through **portraiture** include the Expressionists.



4. Adding text to an image is called **overlay text**. Overlay text can help to **express** the **intention** of the artwork.
