



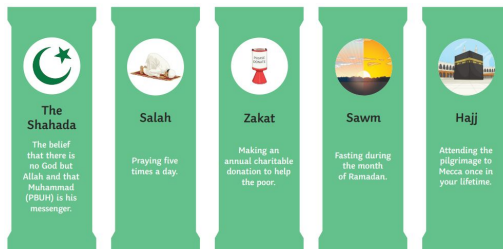
Year 6 Religious Education - Autumn Term 1: Islam



1. **Commitment** means being dedicated to something or someone. You can show commitment by doing something on a regular basis and by demonstrating loyalty, hard work and **belief**.



3. **Zakah** is the third pillar of Islam. It means giving money to **charity**. Muslims think it is their duty to do this as everything they own belongs to God.



2. Muslims follow the 5 **Pillars of Islam**. **Salah** is the act of praying five times a day. **Muslims** believe they need to pray five times to show their belief and be reminded of God so they do not forget about Him.

4. **Sawm** is the fourth pillar of **Islam**. During the month of **Ramadan** every year, **Muslims** do not eat or drink at all during the hours of daylight. **Fasting** is a way of showing that they are living in the way that God wants and remembering people who are hungry. Muslims believe it shows that their religion is the most important thing in their lives.



5. **Muslims** show their commitment to God by: praying five times a day, giving to **charity**, **fasting** during **Ramadan** and visiting **Makkah**.
