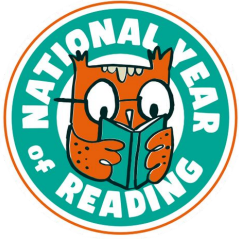

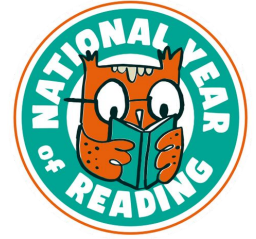

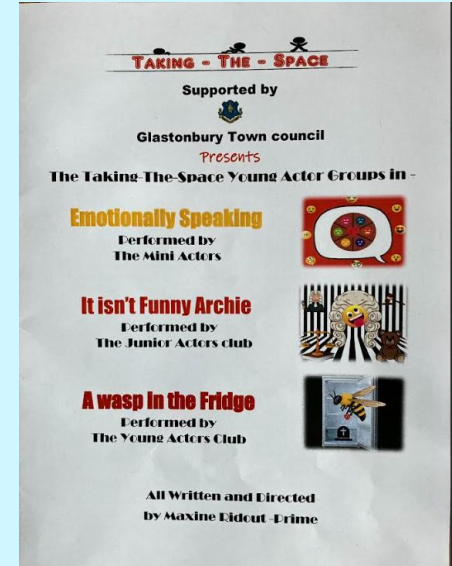


On Saturday 14th and Sunday 15th March, Tyler from Ash class took part in the *Taking-The-Space* performance at Strode Theatre.
