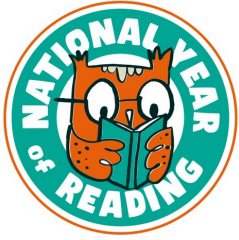

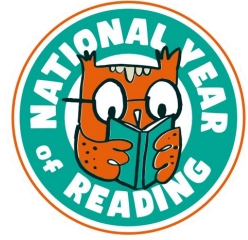

In Art and Design, we created our own clay figurines - inspired by both LS Lowry and a number of famous statues.

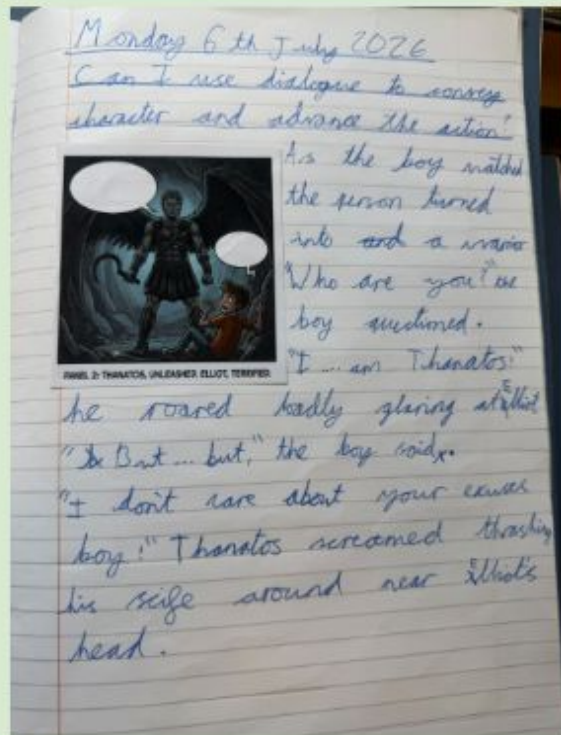
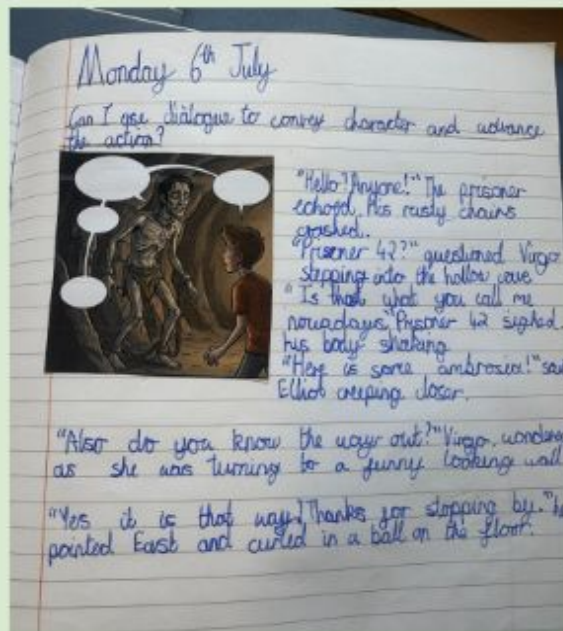
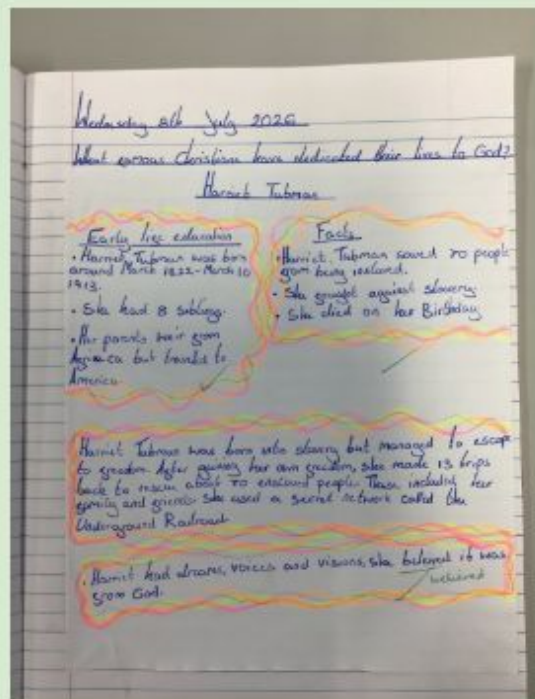


Year 3: Ash & Fir Class
